

This is a residency program for newly graduated BSN nurses with the goal of ensuring supervised transition to autonomous and competent clinical practice in the Veteran-Centric setting of care.

POST-BACCALAUREATE NURSE RESIDENCY (PBNR)

- Application Program
- Eligibility criteria
- 12-month paid academic-based residency
- Curriculum is comprised of a variety of learning opportunities, including didactic, web-based, and simulation training in accordance with Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) Post-Baccalaureate Nurse Residency Program Standards.
- Experiential learning environment that is allocated 100% protected time for BSN graduate nurses in their first registered nursing role
- BSN Preceptor
- Evidence-based practice project required for program completion
